

BNL 006 - 2 DAYS/1 NIGHT SEPILOK ORANGUTAN, SUKAU & GOMANTONG CAVE

DAY 1

Meet our greet guide at hotel or airport and drive for about half an hour to Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre where orphaned and injured orangutan are cared for and rehabilitated for return to the wild. Sepilok is a primary lowland forest, a fine showcase of Borneo's remaining rainforest. Witness the feeding of orangutans from a platform in the forest, and later watch the 25 minutes documentary video on the efforts done by the rehab centre. We then drive for about 2.5hrs through rustic countryside studded with villages. Take a short boat transfer to our lodge. Upon arrival there is a quick safety briefing, and then it's lunch and we check in to our rooms.

At 4pm we go on a wildlife cruise to search for the animals that call this amazing forest home. We get to see primate species including the endemic Proboscis Monkeys as they settle down on treetops. The Kinabatangan Wildlife Sanctuary is one of the best places in Southeast Asia to observe wildlife. Overnight at our river lodge (L,D)

Note: Optional tours - If weather permits, we can go on a night cruise or a jungle walk.

DAY 2

We leave early to visit Gomantong Cave, famed for its edible birds' nests. It's a 15 minutes leisurely walk to Simud Hitam cavern where we will explore the cave system on boardwalk. We then return to Sandakan. End of tour (B)
